Committee on Admission and Practice & Rules Advisory Committee

Pursuant to the Court's Rules of Admission and Practice, Rule 2(a), and the Rules of Practice and Procedure, Rule 40, the Court is seeking letters of interest from members of the Court's bar who would like to serve on the Court's Committee on Admission and Practice or the Rules Advisory Committee. Both committees have significant responsibilities, requiring diligence and sound judgement.

The Committee on Admission and Practice performs investigations, holds hearings, and makes recommendations to the Court regarding disciplinary grievances filed against attorneys and other practitioners who appear before the Court. The Committee is composed of nine members who generally sit in panels of three to review individual grievances referred to them. Currently, the Committee has one vacancy, with additional vacancies possible in the near future.

The Rules Advisory Committee studies and advises the Court on possible changes to the Rules of the Court, either sua sponte or at the request of the Court. The Committee is composed of nine members, with two projected vacancies as of July 1, 2015. Additional vacancies are possible later this year.

Although letters of interest are accepted on an ongoing basis, in light of the current and pending vacancies, interested parties are requested to promptly submit their letters of interest, with a resume, to the Clerk of the Court:
