IN RE: RECALL OF RETIRED JUDGE

ORDER

Pursuant to 38 U.S.C. § 7257(b)(1), eligible retired Judges of the Court may be recalled by the Chief Judge when further service is needed by the Court. Retired Judge Margaret Bartley, having complied with 38 U.S.C. § 7257, is designated a recall-eligible retired Judge. The Chief Judge of the Court has determined that, if recalled, Judge Bartley would provide substantial service necessary to meet the needs of the Court.

Upon consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that, effective June 25, 2026, through December 31, 2026, recall-eligible retired Judge Bartley is recalled from retired status in accordance with 38 U.S.C. § 7257(b)(1). Judge Bartley shall have and exercise all the judicial powers and duties of the office of a Judge in active service and shall otherwise perform substantial service for the Court as requested by the Chief Judge. It is further

ORDERED that Judge Bartley shall serve in recalled status from June 25, 2026, through December 31, 2026, to review and decide appeals, motions, and other filings with the Court and to perform other substantial service at the request of the Chief Judge. During this period, she may serve for up to 90 days, or its equivalent. With her consent, Judge Bartley's service may be extended beyond 90 days.
