IN RE: STANDING PANEL ON ADMISSION AND DISCIPLINE

ORDER

Pursuant to Rule 1(c) of the Court's Rules of Admission and Practice (Rules), the Court created a Standing Panel on Admission and Discipline (Standing Panel) to consider accusations of professional misconduct coming before the Court. The Court's March 11, 2011, Resolution regarding the Standing Panel provides that "the Clerk shall designate as the next member of the Standing Panel the regular active judge with highest precedence among judges who have not yet been designated as a member of the Standing Panel, or there being none, the regular active judge with the longest period of time since last service as a regular member of the Standing Panel."

There are no active judges who have not yet been designated as a member of the Standing Panel. Judge Toth is the regular active judge with the longest period of time since last serving as a member of the Standing Panel, followed by Judge Falvey. Accordingly, the current Standing Panel, comprised of Judges Pietsch, Bartley, and Meredith, will be reconstituted effective July 16, 2026, to be comprised of Judges Pietsch, Meredith, and Toth. In addition, effective August 1, 2026, the Standing Panel, comprised of Judges Pietsch, Meredith, and Toth, will be reconstituted to be comprised of Judges Meredith, Toth, and Falvey.

Upon consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that, effective July 16, 2026, the Standing Panel consists of Judges Pietsch, Meredith, and Toth. It is further

ORDERED that, effective August 1, 2026, the Standing Panel consists of Judges Meredith, Toth, and Falvey.
